

Who needs to be trained?

All adult leaders should hold a current first aid qualification. If you hold a Guide Association qualification (e.g. First Response) it must be renewed every 3 years to remain current. First Aid or Emergency Aid qualifications from other bodies are acceptable qualifications provided that they cover the syllabus required by the Guide Association - for more information speak to your Commissioner or see Appendix 2 Page 41 of the Leadership Qualification Revised Edition 2004.

When and Where?

What do we mean by “NEW” or “RENEWAL”?

Sessions marked “NEW” are for those new to First Response or those who are unsure and would like a more intensive renewal session.

Sessions marked “RENEWAL” are for those who are confident with their existing skills but whose qualification needs to be renewed as it is approaching three years since their last First Response session.

If it is more than three years since your last First Response session please give a new and renewal option so that you may be allocated the most suitable session.

How much will it cost and what do I need to bring?

The course will cost £5.00 which may be taken from Unit Funds. This will include a course book for you to take away and refer to in the future. Drinks are provided. Please bring a pen and paper and a blanket you do not mind using on the floor. Please wear your choice of comfortable clothing from the Guide Wear range. If you are attending a full day session please bring a packed lunch.
