



## The Penny Hardwick Team Award

Core teams of up to 10 people.  
(Larger teams by agreement with the county commissioner)

### **Nomination Criteria**

The team must have achieved a special goal. This could be a one-off event, a short or long term project.

Or

The team must have provided an outstanding range of Girlguiding opportunities over a sustained period of time.

Effective teamwork through collaboration and open communication must be demonstrated and examples of how the team's efforts have given significant benefit to Girlguiding and/or the local community must be included.

Any team must be nominated for achievements that go above and beyond what is expected of their role(s).

Special project teams e.g. WS/Lord Mayors Show etc.

Commissioner Teams

Division / District Teams

Whole Unit Leadership Teams\*

Training teams

\*Only in exceptional circumstances will nominations for members of a Unit Leadership Team be accepted and you are encouraged to discuss these cases with the Chair of the Awards Committee before submitting a nomination.

A Unit Leadership Team includes: Leaders, Assistants, Unit Helpers, Leaders in Training, Young Leaders, Rainbow/Guide Helpers (anyone registered on GO with a member role in your unit)
